This pastor directs Buford Road Campus (BRC) assimilation ministries and serves as ministry "champion" for discipleship across all campuses of Bon Air Baptist Church.

- Works with Children and Student Ministries to create discipleship pathways that connect with Adult Discipleship Ministries.
- Works with Lead Pastor to create church-wide discipleship events.
- Oversees promotion of BRC discipleship programs, events, activities, and church-wide discipleship experiences through print, social media, website, worship slides, etc.
- Creates and administers programs to welcome and assimilate new believers, new members, and regular attenders into the life of the church.
- Directs the new members' classes.
- Oversees maintenance of membership records in the database.
- Promotes training and leadership development opportunities for the BRC family.
- Serves as staff liaison for teams: Adult Discipleship Team, Engage and Place Team, Library Team, Prayer Team, and Bon Books & Brew Team (coffee shop and bookstore).
- Coordinates the ministry of Bon Books & Brew.

- Prepares annual budget for BRC Discipleship.
- Understands and embraces Emotionally Healthy Spirituality as created by Peter Scazzero (www.emotionallyhealthy.org).
